School: East Heights Early Childhood Family Center

Partners: Dr. Green & Dr. Otten

Partner Activities:

Dr. Green – Yearly vision screenings for all out children and for PAT families as requested.

Dr. Otten – Provides 5 new toothbrushes a year for each child. His hygienists participate in 1 of our family fun nights.

School Activities: Recognize them in our monthly newsletter sent home to each family. Send them copies of our school newsletter. Kids make life-size “thank you” cards for them to display in their business.

School: Pinckney Elementary

Partners: Lawrence Memorial Hospital & Gould Evans

Partner Activities: Partnership Day, April 20th. Each year the partners plan and implement a day-long series of age-appropriate activities revolving around a common theme such as: measurement, safety, pet care or history (this year).

School Activities: Teachers bring classes to the gym, one class at a time, to participate in the activity stations presented by the business partner.

School: Woodlawn
